We ask that you please respond to each question, in writing, no later than close of business on Friday, August 23rd.

- 1. Was there a specific event or an accumulation of events that motivated you to submit a letter of resignation? What was/were those events? And to whom did you submit the letter?
- 2. What were your specific concerns about the direction of the department?
- 3. Did you ever have a conversation with Commissioner Lourey about your concern about the direction of the department? And how were your concerns received?
- 4. Did you ever have a conversation with Governor Walz or his staff about your concerns with the direction of the department? If so, who did you speak with? And how were your concerns received?
- 5. Do you believe that Commissioner Lourey's vision for the agency differed from Governor Walz's vision? If so, what were the differences?
- 6. Why did you decide to return to the department? Did anyone specifically ask you to return? If so, who?

If any answer to the previous questions contains information you don't believe you can legally provide to us, we ask that that information be sent to the Office of the Legislative Auditor for review of confidentiality, and that you include a citation of what specific statute or rule you believe prevents you from sharing that information in your response to us.
