

FRONTLINE WORKER BONUS PAY

Meaningful bonus pay for those who took the most risk to keep us safe

This plan prioritizes workers who willingly walked into COVID wards to care for sick patients, long-term care workers who doubled-down on protections for the vulnerable, first responders who kept going to emergency calls and officers who managed convicted criminals. These were the heroes who held the hands of dying patients when families were not allowed to be there and kept our communities safe even when it meant putting their own health at risk.

It provides \$1200 bonus pay from the \$250 million after an application is approved so workers can get these bonus payments as soon as possible. They earned it.

Nurses, first responders, corrections officers, long-term care workers, and hospice staff took the biggest risks during COVID. They couldn't work from home and they showed up every day to do their job.

Who is Eligible:

Nurses, first responders, corrections officers, LTC workers, hospice providers

How Much:

\$1,200 bonus pay

Requirements:

- · Couldn't telecommute or work from home
- · Received less than 1 month of unemployment
- Minimum 1200 hours worked between March 2020-December 2020
- No income cap
- The application process will quickly turn around the funds as they are approved
