As it sits today, 6/12/2025 the MN-DOC has 1272 open bedspaces at every institution combined.

MCF-STW has 362 open beds that are factored into this.

Subtracting MCF-STW open beds from the grand total leaves 809 open beds.

MCF-SHK is a female institution that has 98 open beds. Ethically and morally, they should not accept male inmates.

This would lower the grand total to 711 open beds.

MCF-ST.CLOUD is currently undergoing updates, and will have one unit shut down until the projects are completed. They are listed as having 145 open beds, unsure if that includes the shut down unit. Grand total is now 566 open beds.

MCF-REDWING is a juvenile facility that has 8 open beds. Grand total of open bed space is now 558.

MCF-ST.CLOUD is the intake facility, it would be unwise to fill them to max capacity from transfers out of MCF-STW.

MCF-STW has an onsite population of 1124 inmates.

The planned closure of MCF-STW leaves the DOC with an excess of 628 inmates over capacity.

These totals do not factor in the 43 projected incomings, compared to the 19 outgoing.

The plan seems to be is to house roughly 550 inmates at MCF-STW until its full closure.

As it sits that's 78 inmates without bed space, and then 550 more when MCF-STW finally closes.

Pushing nearly all other facilities to max population is dangerous and inhumane.

The DOC Commissioner has routinely stated he will not do early releases, but over 600 releases need to happen without

any more new admits and release violators over the next 4 years. The DOC inmate population has risen significantly over the years.
